### B. CMAS & PARRC achievement

Joel shared Bromwell scores. Overall students in grades 3 – 5th scored in the top 90th percentile and placed in the top 5 within the district. Additional details will be made available when data is no longer embargoed on 12/11.

### C. TLC (Teaching, Learning & Collaboration)

Jody shared DPS vision for TLC Program to significantly improve student outcomes by deploying teacher leaders in consistently defined roles to drive Teaching, Leadership, and Culture strategies across all schools by 2018.

- Increase distributive leadership      Build stronger leadership teams while growing and developing potential school leaders

Additional details and feasibility will be a part of the 2015-2016 budget process.

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- to enhance student achievement and school climate by building relationships, increasing involvement and providing a forum for input to engage the community in collaborative efforts supporting school and District goals.
- to provide input and strategic direction to the school's SIP and mission/vision, which with the school's program design, serves as the strategic plan for the school.
- to provide guidance, use measures/methods of evaluation in order to approve the SIP and the annual budget as well as aid in alignment of staffing/resources.

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### D. Marketing Bromwell-Developing a Bromwell Brochure

Jody shared results of her recent meeting with the DPS Marketing Representative. The representative is working on a cost estimate of how they might highlight what makes Bromwell such a unique and exemplary school (Phase One). To increase transparency, she will also be creating an Infographic regarding how the Student Based Budget and the PTA Grant is allocated within the school. For Phase Two, she will present options for branding the school to include banners inside and outside along with coordinating the schools social media.
