- I. Fundraising
 - a. **Annual Fund Reflections/2019 Chair (Amy Butz)** – Thank you Letters are done and sent; fundraising was a success with a \$105,852 including monthly donations. Participation rate was 90%, with 4th Grade at 100%; About \$3000 came from friends and family.
Would like to reach out to Alumni. Sugg to use Colorado Gives Day to do so.
 - b. **Auction (Jodi Sewell)** Save the date for May 4th, 2018. The theme will be different than originally announced and committee will reach out to community for ideas and vote. 5 people are actively working on acquisitions; Sponsorship goal is \$25K-30K. Trying to reach business as early as possible to offer full-year exposure.
- II. Financial
 - a. **Update on Classroom Grants (Carla Beal)**
 - i. Teachers' Grants \$1800/\$8750 allocated
 - ii. Classroom Grants \$3400/\$7000 allocated
 - b. **Update on 25k spending (x3 years) (Andrew Hodges)**
 - i. **TruTouch Boards:** Started to include them in the rotation in classes with the most urgent need for replacement.
 - ii. **Soccer Goals:** 2 soccer goals have been purchased for \$1148 total, \$150 year-over-year for maintenance via PE budget.
 - iii. **STEM supplies:** Revisited the amount of 3D printers to 2 (instead of 3) because of space; Tentatively \$1100 will be for STEM lab kits, free drones donated by local company.
 - iv. **K/1 iPads:** Not yet in the works. 29 iPads to be replaced as they break with phasing out to Chrome books from 2nd Grade on. The goal is to have 3 new per room to eventually 15 per classroom.
 - v. **Plus:** Guided Reading Books \$12,000 – CSC to look into this. Sugg: to have an Auction item for this.
 - vi. **Plus:** New signage at crosswalk to be installed soon.

- c. **Missoula** Wrap up (Jennifer Turner and Erin Sorce) – Another success this year. Kids had difficulties during first part of the week, but by Thursday, they were just like pros.
