Quick notes: 297 people completed surveys: 21 chose 100% virtual remote learning, 15% was district wide. Majority in favor of in-person learning. Will call small groups "Learning Sleuths." First day of school Aug. 24th.

Need to put together survey so hopefully we can group people with friends they are already hanging out with.

### **Agenda:**

#### **1) Ideas for socially distant community events to kick off school as well as the annual fund:**

- Poster contest - "Wipe your paws"
- Picnic table - get wood picnic tables, kids can paint outside
- Bike parade through Cheesman Park
- Virtual idea - Zoom Afternoon Tea after first week to get feedback to see how things went, give feedback to teachers and Valecia
- Bike or car parade on 7th Ave pkwy
- Movie nights - can still do Brother's BBQ, each family picks up from Brother's.
  - Set up our own Drive In Movie - find big parking lot - East High School? South High School?
- Weekly survey to see what morale is - stay on top of communication, morale and stay in front of frustration
- what about roving dinner parties for kids? we can do groups of 10 or less

#### **2) Hybrid model plan and outdoor learning spaces** - Most likely will be hybrid after Labor Day.

- DPS talking about A/B days, which seems likely
- No parents allowed inside
- District purchased Seesaw for K-5, then Schoology for 6-12
- So far, teachers haven't heard what curriculums the school is using, things are changing so quickly it's hard to know what would be helpful

#### **Outdoor:**

- Teachers really liking shade so can be outside
- Tents, clipboards and sunscreen
- Sounds like teachers support being outside for lunch, art, as much as possible

#### **3) Wish list for virtual learning plan**

Wishes:

- good to have parent zoom's every week or every other week to vent, get together and see what real needs and challenges are
- Boom cards - lots of sight words, math, science

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- a good clear, consistent plan and messaging - the constant change leads to confusion and frustration
- sounds like teachers might have access to schools/buildings so can utilize their own classroom and materials

**4) HVAC improvements**

- Bromwell is going to get a nice cleaning - \$5million most likely going to other schools who don't have A/C already
- Kindergarten's class rooms are a concern - Ms Ford's room is already the hottest in the building - Kindergarten's rooms have less circulation and are both hot.

**5) Teacher support**

- Idea of getting teachers scrubs
- Masks with Bromwell bears
- Polis said teachers are getting medical high grade masks - he secured PPE. These are not N95 but just one grade lower
- Shade outside is a great idea
